Lessons From a Boat Builder

In the first six chapters of Genesis, you will see the downward spiral of humanity from a perfect relationship with God to doing whatever pleases them. Cain murders Abel. Lamech is the first man in the biblical text to have more than one wife. Then, he kills a man and writes a poem about it, justifying himself and pronouncing judgment on anyone who might take revenge on him. In Genesis 6, the situation was so dire the Lord decided to wash the earth clean and start over. Amidst this evil, one man stood out, Noah.

In Genesis 6:8, you're introduced to this man of God for the first time. The text says, "But, Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord." As the historical account develops, you learn why this man found favor in the eyes of the Lord. The Hebrews writer said he moved with "godly fear" when instructed to build the ark (Heb 11:7). His actions starkly contrasted with the world set on continually doing evil. His example teaches us many faith building lessons.

First, grace was extended to Noah and his family. While Noah wasn't set on continually doing evil, he did have feet of clay. After getting off the ark in Genesis 9, he planted a vineyard and got drunk. Suffice it to say that Noah deserved the same fate as the people living before the flood but was allowed to live. This could be said of every human who has lived since. You deserve death (Rom 3:23; 6:23), but you're given divine favor (Eph 2:8-9; 1 Cor 15:10).

Second, Noah took action and obeyed God. Two times in Genesis 6-7, the Bible says Noah did all the Lord commanded him (6:22; 7:5). As previously stated, the Hebrews writer noted that he "moved with godly fear." After God gave grace, Noah responded with obedience. No, you cannot earn God's grace, but it does have an expectation. Grace prepares and strengthens you to serve the Lord (Eph 2:10; 2 Tim 2:1). Every opportunity to serve is a door opened by God's grace.

Third, Noah paid attention to details. In Genesis 6:14-16 the LORD gave Noah specific instructions and Noah did every one. Is God interested in details? You don't have to read far into the Bible to learn the answer is a resounding, "Yes!" Let us be diligent in learning God's details.

It is interesting what you can learn from an ancient boat builder. Let us strive to move with godly fear as Noah did, setting an example and preaching righteousness (2 Pet 2:5). The world will be a better place due to God's people and our influence.
