I'M LOOKING FOR A CHURCH THAT IS NOT SO... Matt. 7:1-5

INTRO:

- 1. Someone out there is looking for a new church.
- 2. They have some criteria that they are looking for.

I. ...DOGMATIC.

II. ...JUDGMENTAL.

- A. There are so many folks out there that have come from dysfunctional situations that they are not looking for somewhere they can go to receive more criticism.
- B. The church is composed of kind people that know their imperfections.
- C. All Christians, like John, have a hopeful future; but many, like Paul, also have a regrettable past. Rev. 21:1-3; Phil. 3:13
- D. Since all have sinned, Christians understand, accept, encourage, and help each other.
- E. We can all quote Jesus' admonition. Matt. 7:1
 - 1. However, we must make judgments. Jesus also said **John 7:24.**
 - 2. He doesn't forbid judging, but he does forbid unfair, hypocritical judging. **Matt. 7:2-5**
- F. The church proclaims the righteousness of God. Rom. 1:16, 17; Rom. 3:22-25; Heb. 1:8
 - 1. It declares holiness; values purity, and endorses clear ethical standards.
 - 2. It encourages sowing to the Spirit and discourages sowing to the flesh. Gal. 6:7, 8
 - 3. Therefore, some sermons will encourage us and some will convict us. **Acts 2:36-38**
- G. We want to be a church where folks feel welcomed and loved, and challenged to grow spiritually. 1 Pet. 2:1-2; 21-22; 2 Pet. 3:18
