## HOW'S YOUR HEARING? Luke 8:18

#### INTRO:

- 1. One in eight people over the age of 12 has some form of hearing loss.
- 2. For those of us over 65 that number is one in three.
- 3. Poor hearing affects many people whose auditory ability is excellent.
- 4. Hearing is one thing, but listening is something else.
- 5. How do we hear what Jesus says?
- 6. Are we listening?

#### I. SOME HEAR JESUS GLADLY.

- A. There are those that are looking for truth and recognize it when they hear it. Matt.5:6; John 8:31, 32
- B. Many that gladly hear, immediately obey. Acts 2:41

### II. SOME HEAR JESUS CONTINUALLY.

- A. These are those that hear him over and over and yet have no desire to respond in a positive way.

  Acts 17:32
- B. They are like the soil that never allowed the seed to germinate. Matt. 13:3, 4
- C. They hear, but aren't really listening. Matt. 13:13-15

## III. SOME HEAR JESUS ARGUMENTATIVELY.

- A. They are like the Pharisees that wanted to be able to accuse him. Luke 11:53, 54; John 8:43-47
- B. They hear Jesus with preconceived ideas and traditions.
- C. They will see what he says, but will not accept it as truth. **Matt. 15:6-9**
